As directed by the last CSCC meeting, I voted against the first proposal and abstained on the second proposal (although the more contentious wording of the first proposal had been amended by the time a vote was taken). I also attended the BCA council meeting that followed the AGM (minutes don't appear to be on the BCA website yet). The main topic that was discussed was the creation of a "CRoW Liaison" post, which is being filled by Tim Allen.
